8:30AM - 2:00PM

The Greentree Village Community Association holds two (2) Yard Sales per year in the large open field between Silvervine Lane and Field Master Drive behind Summer Grape Court. The Yard Sales are generally scheduled in the Spring and Fall between the hours of 8:00AM and 2:00PM. Specific dates will be announced on the Community Bulletin Board and on the web at www.greentreevillage.net.

The Association will provide Yard Sale Posterboard Signs at local major intersections and along our road.

Tips for the Seller

- Get Change (i.e., \$20.00 in coins, \$50 in ones, \$40 in fives).
- Create a list of minimum prices you will accept for each item.
- Make arrangements to pickup your leftovers no later than 2:30PM.
- Display like items / complimentary items together.
- Make sure everything is clearly visible and organize it.
- Get a good night's sleep.
- Start setting up 1-2 hours before sales scheduled to start at 9:00AM.
- Set up refreshments.
- Have Fun!

A good rule is to discard anything that you have not used in more than a year. Test each item to make sure it works. Nice looking items turn more heads than trashy looking ones. Consider selling things like baby equipment that could mean a lot to someone with limited resources. Also, include items that you have put into storage because you did not want to display them in your home. *Sell that set of salt and peppershakers in the shape of dice that you bought in Vegas!* Never overlook items because you think that they will not sell. This includes broken costume jewelry, tarnished utensils, broken furniture, jars of nuts and bolts, your old pair of bellbottoms, or even half-burned candles.

Remember, what is your junk is someone else's treasure. People disassemble broken jewelry and use the beads, stones and hooks for arts and crafts. Folks collect the strangest things, such as oddball salt and peppershakers, handy people can repair broken furniture and appliances, and teenagers love the look of outdated clothing! The worst that can happen is that you will not sell it, so you have nothing to lose!

You may use tables or blankets and we do ask that everyone clean up their area once the sale has ended.
